The elegantly sweet sound of the campus carrillon filled the campus air as forty-one newly installed bells joined "Old Aggie" – the clock chime – in the Old Chapel clock tower.

In June, members of the Class of 1954 returned to campus, many for the first time since graduation. Amongst these alumni were 6 members of the Women's Drill Team, a legendary group of gals who, from 1946 to 1970, entertained crowds with their precision marching.

After the annual alumni meeting which serves as the unofficial kickoff to Reunion Weekend, a group of "Gray Ladies" (gray being the color of their uniforms) reminisced what life at UMass Amherst was like in the '50s, and marveled at the wonderous changes the campus has seen.

During rehearsal for the evening's festivities, **Kerstin Becker '96** greeted drill team members and their husbands on behalf of the band. Kerstin and the drill team alumni compared her newly published tome with memories that seem to recall events of last week.

"What an amazing accomplishment," many remarked.

Following rehearsal, on a tour of the Mullins Center, drill team member Jean Flaherty Prendergast '54 and her husband recalled fond memories of campus, comparing facilities of the day to the amenity-rich arena now home to Minuteman Basketball and Ice Hockey.

The Predergasts had driven to Amherst from their home in Cleveland, missing the group tour given the night before.

"[This] was an organization that was the talk of every New England campus where they appeared," recalled drillmaster Clem Burlingame '54.

With clean white gloves and smart atten-

tion in their salutes, these women, now past the age of 70, proudly marched on stage (during a lively class banquet) to a recent Minuteman Band recording of "Fight Mass" – a rendition unlike the one they remembered so fondly.

Their energy and love for our alma mater shows the pride in and the traditions of the Power & Class go back through the generations.
